# Topstock Standard Requirements

### **Visually Organized**

- Above Modular home (or adjacent 4 ft section)
- Left-hand justified grouped together
- One barcode facing out per SKU

### Organized Eaches and Cases

- Up to 3 cases per item on Topstock shelf
  - Additional overstock in Exception Overstock Bins in backroom
- Use WACO's for items that can't be neatly stacked.
  - No more than 3 UPCs per WACO.
  - Do not write on or label from of WACO boxes.
- Items in Shelf Ready packaging/PDQ are kept in the case.
- To aid in taking safety precautions merchandise should never hand over the self edge.
  - WACO boxes may extend over the back edge of the self due to their size

### Safely Stacked

- Stacked at a maximum height of 20".
- DO NOT stack glass eaches.
- Canned eaches may be stacked two high is they nest when stacked.
- Unopened glass cases can be stacked maximum of 2 high.
- 25lb max per item.






# Topstock Shelving Components

### 4 Pieces for Shelving


- 1. Extenders allow for extra height on top of the existing modular
- 2. 16" shelf
- 3. Ask for Assistance Strip (inserted into fast track on 16" shelf)
- 4. Aisle Location Label



### **Special Exceptions**

- 1. Basket Shelves
- 2. WACO's for pegged items
- 3. Backer Panels
- 4. Super Heavy Duty Extenders (only used on half gondolas).
- 5. Giraffe Shelves (cannot be used with extensions)







### Basket Shelves

### Categories that require a Basket Shelf

- Bed Pillows
- Contact Paper
- Décor Pillows
- Fleece
- Mattress Pad/Toppers
- Pillow Rests
- Poly Fill
- Ribbon
- Yarn









## Gooseneck Navigational Signing

## WACO Storage



- Gooseneck signing can be installed either above or below the Topstock shelf.
- The bottom of the sign must be a minimum of 78 inches above the floor and profiled down each sidecounter for safety.



- Walmart Approved Corrugated Organizer
- Use WACOs to hold pegged items, eaches or items that do not stack safely
- Only use small or medium WACOs



### Backer Panels

### Carts



 Install Backer Panels in high visibility area like hotspots and Action Alley where Topstock categories back up to non-Topstock categories.



- Use to get product from the top shelf safely.
- Do not use for storage
- Only use one cart per associate per aisle





# Only Install Topstock Fixture in Approved Areas









### Basic Install



Shelf Strip
16" Shelf
12" Extender

- Make sure the modular is set correctly before installing the Topstock shelf
  - Incorrect mods cause plugging and Topstock shelves to be installed too high
- Place 12" extenders
- Before installing top shelf, add fast track to top shelf, install Ask for Assistance strip and aisle location label
- Install Shelf Set height as low as possible to the tallest modular item in the aisle.
  - Profile shelves at the same height down each sidecounter.

**Helpful Hint:** It is easier to install Fast Track and Ask for Assistance signage before installing the Topstock shelf

**Helpful Hint**: Goosenecks and aisle navigation signage should be profiled at the same height down each sidecounter.



### Topstock Install Notes

# Correct

- Shelves are profiled to the tallest item on the top shelf of the modular
- Shelves are installed as low as possible
- Ask for Assistance shelf strips are installed on each Topstock shelf
- Aisle Location labels are left-hand justified on each Topstock shelf
- All teeth of the Topstock shelf must be secured in the extender or upright
- For each Topstock category, all 4 teeth of the Topstock shelf will safely install into the extender

### Incorrect X



- Missing Ask for Assistance shelf strip
- Shelves are not profiled at the same height
- Missing aisle location label
- Noticeable gap shelves should be set as low as possible to maintain consistent height on each side of the aisle.
- Do not stack extender, Approved Topstock categories do not require stacked extenders.



## Installation Exceptions

#### Installation

- Typically 16" shelves will work without extenders
- Make sure fixtures against the wall are bolted and anchored.
   Work with your Implementation Team for any fixtures that are not properly anchored.
  - You should not need extenders on counters bolted to perimeter walls.

### Giraffe Shelves (only use when necessary)

- If 16" shelf cannot be installed (typically due to capped gondolas.)
  - Order via GNFR
  - Perimeter mods may require giraffe shelves if a regular 16" shelf will not fit.







# Management Verification Prior to Moving Forward

Verified mods are set correctly and plugged overstock removed?	<b>1</b>	X
Topstock shelves are installed profiled and as low as possible?	<b>1</b>	X
Ensure all Topstock shelves have an Ask for Assistance shelf strip and left hand justified aisle location label?	<b>✓</b>	X
Ensure Topstock shelves are installed above approved categories?	<b>✓</b>	X
Ensure Topstock shelves are not installed above excluded categories and sections?	<b>✓</b>	X
Established excitations with all associates by teaching and training Topstock standards?	1	X

Note: Correct any issues with installation before placing items on the Topstock shelf.

# Departments Not Included in Topstock

There are exceptions within several departments where Topstock shelves are not installed.

These exceptions are based on

- Safety
- Item Size
- Mod Design
- Display Prevents Install
- High Theft Item

Partner with your Team Lead should you have any questions.



## Special Circumstances

- Columns through Mods: Requires column shelf that can be cut
- Perimeter Mods: Requires shelves, but not extenders
- Warehouse Steel: Needs Grates and Beams if not in place
- Capped Gondolas: Use Giraffe shelves if necessary
- Backer Panels: Used in Topstock area that back up to non-Topstock areas
- Conduit: Requires an electrician to move
- High Shrink Items: DO NOT place high shrink items on top shelf
- Pool Chemicals: DO NOT install Topstock fixtures above pool chemicals
- Cornice Signing: Cornice signing mounted to the sidecounter can be removed
